

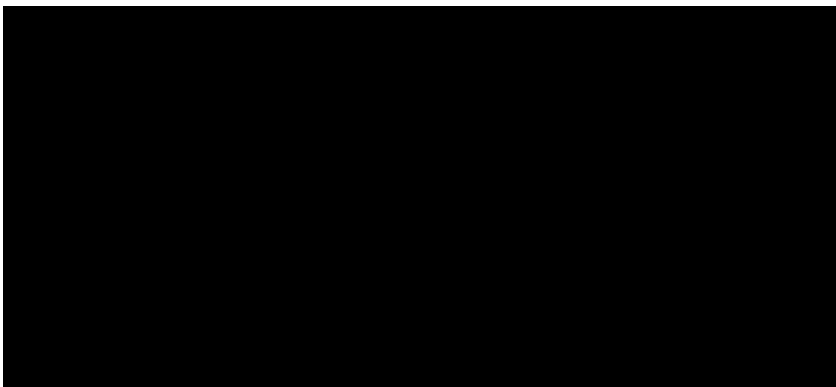
In an effort to continue with its mission to “glorify God and serve His Church by providing higher education centered in Holy Scripture and shaped by Wesleyan conviction,” God’s Bible School and College (GBSC) enters this articulation agreement with Allegheny Wesleyan College (AWC).

GBSC agrees to accept transfer credits as detailed in the Transfer Guide into GBSC’s *Bachelor of Arts Degree with a Major in Teacher Education (Early Childhood)* and *Bachelor of Arts Degree with a Major in Music Education (Choral/General Music)*, provided the credits have a grade of C- or above.

Students from AWC seeking to enroll at GBSC under this agreement must meet all GBSC admissions requirements by applying to GBSC; admission to GBSC is not guaranteed by this agreement.

AWC agrees to notify GBSC of any change in its accreditation or other approval. AWC may promote this agreement in any way it chooses, provided GBSC gives prior approval to any published (including electronically) material. GBSC will disclose this agreement on its website in compliance with oversight requirements regarding articulation agreements.

This agreement is valid for the academic year in which it is initiated. It automatically renews each year thereafter unless GBSC or AWC gives the other institution written notice ending the agreement; in the case of such written notice being provided, the agreement will terminate after the academic year then underway.
