

Worship Sequence - Father's Day

Prelude

- MCII 4 F *He Is Exalted*
- MCII 32 F *Worthy of Worship* (F-4; F7-2.5)
- 33 Bb *How Great Thou Art* (Bb-4; Bb7-3)
- 105 Eb *Day by Day*
- MCII 13 Bb *Be Exalted, O God*

Welcome

Call to Worship: May be read by pastor or another member of the congregation. This is a great place to involve children!

Invocation Prayer: Typically pastor or worship leader prays here. Musicians can begin playing first hymn quietly in the background.

- MCII 14 Bb *Blessed Be the Lord God Almighty* (big ritard; Bb-2; Bb7-1)
- 75 Eb *This Is My Father's World* (Eb-3.5; into Intro)
- F *He Knows My Name* (directly into)
- HG 80 F *How Deep the Father's Love for Us*
- Greeting
- Prayer Song - MCII 75 Eb *Think About His Love*

Prayer: This is the main pastoral prayer for the service. Musicians may continue playing *the last song* softly behind prayer for continued worshipful atmosphere.

Notes

- If using another hymnbook, note that different keys may be used.
- Lillenas Music publishes orchestra accompaniment books that can supplement resources for an instrumental ensemble within the worship service.
- Transitions are listed to indicate how many beats per chord in between selection.
 - E.g., (F-4; F7-2.5) =
 - Play the last chord of the previous song (F major) for 4 beats; transition into the next selection by playing an F7 chord for 2 and a half beats, and proceed directly into the next selection.
- *He Knows My Name* may be substituted for either of the following in the worship sequence with a change of key into *How Deep the Father's Love*, if preferred.
 - 727 Eb *A Christian Home* (Eb-4; Gm-4; C-3)
 - 726 Eb *Find Us Faithful* (Eb-4; Gm-4; C-3)
