

Worship Sequence - Sufficiency of Christ

Prelude

- 4 ***Glorify Thy Name***
- 268 ***Our God Reigns***
- 258 ***Christ Arose***

Welcome

Call to Worship: [Hebrews 10:19-23](#) may be read by pastor or another member of the congregation. This is a great place to involve children!

Invocation Prayer: Typically pastor or worship leader prays here. Musicians can begin playing first hymn quietly in the background.

- 436 ***The Solid Rock*** (F-2, C/D-1, D-2)
- 435 ***My Faith Has Found a Resting Place*** (direct to Eb ***In Christ Alone***, play softly behind scripture reading. After it finishes give brief intro for worship leader)
- Scripture Reading

Prayer: This is the main pastoral prayer for the service. Musicians may continue playing ***the last song*** softly behind prayer for continued worshipful atmosphere.

- Supplementary Text: Chord Sheet for ***In Christ Alone*** and scripture reading

Notes

- If using another hymnbook, note that different keys may be used.
- Lillenas Music publishes orchestra accompaniment books that can supplement resources for an instrumental ensemble within the worship service.
 - Transitions are listed to indicate how many beats per chord in between selection.
 - E.g., (F-3; A-3; D-2) =
 - Play the last chord of the previous song (F major) for 3 beats; transition into the next selection by playing an A major chord for 3 beats, followed by a D major chord for 2 beats, and proceed directly into the next selection.
- Between ***My Faith Has Found a Resting Place*** and ***In Christ Alone***, the musicians will do a direct key change and play quietly behind the [scripture reading](#). The reading is meant to be done by two people, one reading the italics, one the bold. The last line is meant to be recited together
